FASH 'Chat' - Our Winter/Spring Workshops

Our 2024/25 workshop season got off to a splendid start with Victoria Yeomans and musicians Dave Yeomans and Linda Game, and by the time you read this, we will have had our second workshop, with Ivan Aitken and musicians Claire Coxwell, Judith & Rick Beton. But still to come in 2024 is our Winter Gathering, on the 15th December at Durley Memorial Hall SO32 2AD from 10.30am to 3.30pm.

This will be our third Winter Gathering and we are really looking forward to it. We will have our usual mix of popular and brilliant local callers and musicians, Mummers and a sprinkling of music, song and surprises. This is not a workshop. It is instead a day for fun and enjoyment, a great way to start the Christmas season and it's only £6 each, or £3 for a half day. £1 for tea, coffee and biscuits all day, and there will be mince pies and cake, but bring your own lunch.

We kick off 2025 on January 12th at Soberton Village Hall SO32 3PF with The Varied Dances of Phillippe Callens, called by Thomas Bending with Pete & Sue Hall. Phillippe Callens was a superb choreographer who produced some lovely and popular dances, and Pete and Sue will provide suitably beautiful music for us. Thomas is a deservedly well-known caller and musician and we are lucky that he now lives locally and we can get to know him better. Don't miss this workshop!

Next up, on the 2nd February, will be Louise Siddons with Linda Game & Ali

Messer for Not Quite and Mostly Contra, at Durley Memorial Hall. Louise says they will be mainly British Contra style dances – are they Contras? Louise is another famous caller who now lives locally, and Linda and Ali are well known musicians who play for Contras as Box of Frogs. Another brilliant combination of versatile and entertaining caller and musicians!

March 9th is our annual West Gallery Music workshop with The Madding Crowd, at Soberton Village Hall. Come to sing and play, but don't forget to book your place in advance to: *info@fash.org.uk* or 01243 531497.

The 23rd of March sees us back at Durley Memorial Hall with Frances Oates and Pete & Sue Hall and a workshop entitled What Happens Next? Or Frances says it could be called Patterns that I Like, as it will be a mix of some of her favourite dances. Frances is another caller who is popular across the country, at her own club in Cornwall and at clubs, festivals etc, and Pete & Sue will complement her calling with their lovely music.

Our last workshop of the season will be on April 13th at Soberton Village Hall when Jane Thomas will lead us through a Smörgåsbord of Interesting Dances and Tunes, with Pete & Sue Hall. This will be a pick and mix of dance that Jane enjoys teaching and dancing. We always enjoy Jane's calling, she is very popular and it will be good

to have her back again, working with Pete & Sue.

A mention of Wassailing at Fishbourne in January reminded me of Dave McGlade's FASH 'Chat' in this year's February issue of 'Solent Waves' (which is still available on our website at www.fash.org.uk/archive/2021-2030/SW 2024-02.pdf). It prompted me to look at what wassailing events are running in and around Hampshire. There proved to be fewer than I expected.

The event which first drew my attention will take place in Fishbourne, just this side of Chichester, on the 18th January. This will be the first such event to be held at the Fishbourne Playing Fields Centre on Blackboy Lane, Fishbourne, PO18 8BE. 'Kick-off' will be a 7.00 in the evening with local Morris side Fishbourne Mill Morris entertaining the crowd, followed by The Prize Old Mummers performing a traditional Mummers Play. Finally, of course, a procession to the Apple Tree with singing and the traditional drinking of Cider (or beer) while wassailing the tree.

Remember to take something to make a noise with – whistle, rattle or perhaps something to bang – if you are going to join in.

More locally, Butser Ancient Farm are holding an evening 'Wassailing the Orchard' event on the 17th January. More details and tickets are available via their webpage www.butserancientfarm.co.uk/whats-on/.

Also within the county borders, Hartley Wintney will be holding their annual Wassail Night on the 10th January. If you wish to participate, gather at the Wagon and Horses at 6.45, when Hook Eagle Morris Men will put on a lively show before leading the procession to the Vaughan Millennium Orchard. There is no charge for the event and more details can be found on the Parish Council website www.hartleywintney-pc.gov.uk/council events/wassail-2025/.

Mentioning Wassailing of course leads me to thinking about another more or less seasonal event – the traditional Mumming Plays. Our local teams are out as usual as we approach the year end. Broadside Mummers' website is no longer active, but their programme for this year can be found on their Facebook page

www.facebook.com/groups/BroadsideMummers/

The Prize Old Mummers' website has their program on the 'Tour Dates' page; also on the website you can find some of the earlier years' scripts for their plays, many of which offer a rather different spin on the traditional story. King/St. George is always one of the cast, as is the doctor and Father Christmas. The Devil is usually involved as is the Dragon, but how these are woven into the tale tends to vary.

One of POM's tour dates is the 1st January at the Flower Pots pub and brewery — an event to welcome the New Year. This year (still this year, although we are already beginning to think of events nearly a year ago as 'last year') at least three Morris sides were dancing at the Flower Pots, but at the moment only Mary Rose and Royal George appear to have this event included on their programme.

King John's Morris Men's website has been under reconstruction for quite a few months but their Mummers' tour dates are given on their Facebook page www.facebook.com/KingJohnsMorris/. I was

saddened to note from this webpage that the Hampshire Bowman in Dundridge has closed, not for refurbishment as is often the case, but because the tenant landlord is leaving the industry – as he put it: for a better work/life balance with a bit more emphasis on the life bit (I paraphrase a little -Ed).

Hunting around a bit on the internet, I get the impression that both Mumming and Wassailing are traditions that maybe we are beginning to lose. Even just a year or so ago there were clearly quite a few more of these types of events around our area. I can find wassailing mentioned on several websites but as soon as I start to look for the equivalent sites with events in 2025 or even 2024, they simply are not there. I could find evidence of a Boxing Day play at Crookham in 2023, but no indication that there would be one this year.

Similarly, the New Forest Mummers were looking for new recruits in November this year but their Facebook page gives no further indication that a play will take place - perhaps there just were not enough folk interested.

Anyway, enough mourning the apparent loss of some of our traditions. It is good to see some concerts taking place again at Bournemouth Folk Club, although sadly this month's will be last one at the Guildford Institute's Folk Club. Note that the contacts at Focsle Music are now lin@focsle.org and jonathan@focsle.org, no longer Paul.

So finally, as we approach the end of the year, it remains only for me to wish you all, on behalf of the FASH committee, an enjoyable, and perhaps also relaxing, festive break.
